THE RECENT DECISION BY MONITOR AND NHS ENGLAND TO DROP HRG4+

Further to your update of 7th December 2015 on proposals for the 2016/17 tariff: the Institute of Physics and Engineering in Medicine supports and endorses the views expressed in the letter from Members of the Expert Working Group for the Nuclear Medicine Chapter at Casemix, HSCIC and the letter from the Chairman of the Expert Working Groups.

Nuclear Medicine is a multi-disciplinary speciality and the NHS relies on us providing diagnostic and therapeutic procedures of varying complexity and cost. The lack of emphasis on being paid for procedures actually performed and instead getting paid a very low approximation of the actual cost is frustrating for all nuclear medicine practitioners and we would urge an urgent review of the decision as well as re-engagement with the Expert Working Groups who have already spent a lot of their valuable time on trying to get this right.
