Clinical Imaging Board launches posters on radiation risk

The Clinical Imaging Board has launched a series of posters about the use of ionising radiation in imaging. The posters can be printed off and put up in departments to help patients understand the balance of benefits and risks. They supplement the information provided to individual patients. The first posters are about nuclear medicine, CT, and dental x-rays. The next will be fluoroscopy, general x-rays, and symptomatic mammography.
