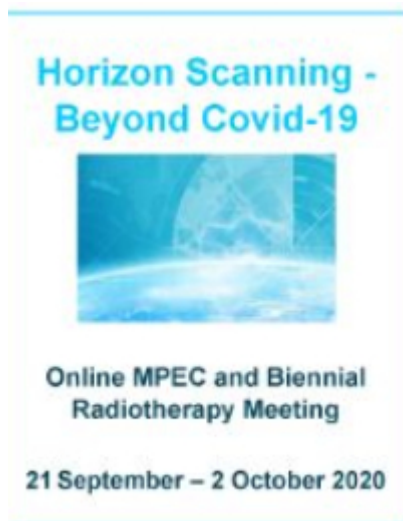

### **MPEC 2020: Horizon Scanning - Beyond Covid-19**

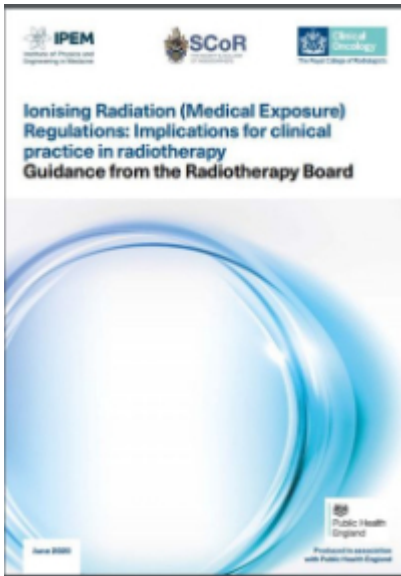
