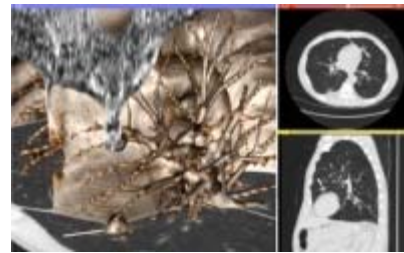
Radiation Assurance
