Successful online AGM at MPEC

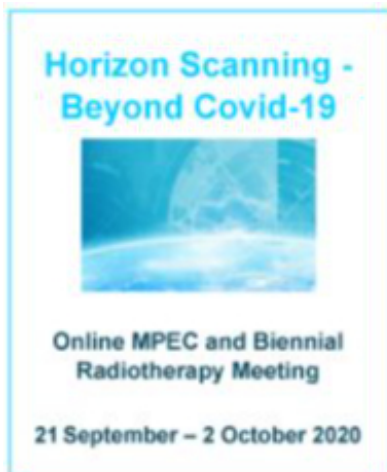

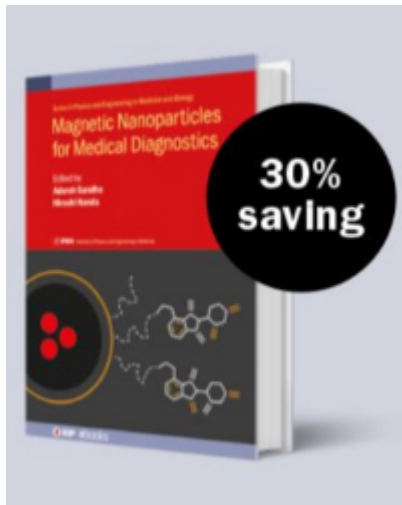


Environmental sustainability - your views wanted
