A service to celebrate the Year of Engineering is being held at Westminster Abbey next month. A number of IPEM members will be attending.

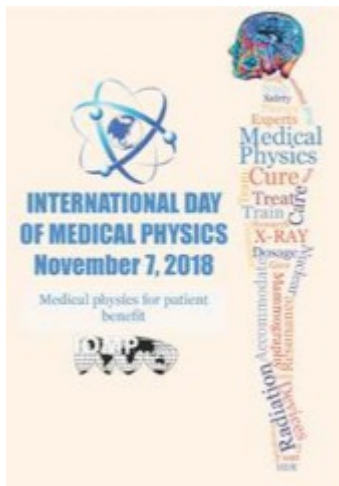
