



Guidance and further information: Roy Ellis Patient Benefit Award

The IPEM Roy Ellis Patient Benefit Award is open to all IPEM members, both from the UK and overseas. The closing date for applications is normally 30th April.

1. Applicants or nominators must complete the application form and submit evidence to support the application.
2. The Prize is awarded to any member for a specific piece of work or project that benefits patients. This may be directly, for example, designing a bespoke device or indirectly, for example, producing an information leaflet or providing advice on a website. One Roy Ellis Patient Benefit Award is awarded each year.
3. The name of the prize winner will be announced in the Newsletter and on the website in August. All unsuccessful applicants/nominators will be notified by email by early to mid August.
4. The Prize winner will be invited to the awards ceremony at the Science, Technology and Engineering Forum usually held in September, to receive the award from the IPEM President.
5. Rewards
